## **Cracking and wind slab formation at Bridger**

Wind was ripping on the ridge and creating hard wind slabs 3-6" in depth. Without much new snow to transport they weren't very large or widespread, but we got cracking and <u>propagation</u> on a steeper terrain feature (Hidden) near the ridge that led to us skiing a different line. The <u>slab</u> development was also found in isolated areas further down from the ridge in cross loaded gullies, but slabs were isolated to breaking at the skis.
